

#### AWARNING

SET-UP AND PRE-DELIVERY SERVICE MUST BE PERFORMED BY AN AUTHORIZED HONDA DEALER. Proper set up and pre-delivery service is essential to rider safety and reliability of the motorcycle. When a customer takes delivery of his brand new motorcycle, he expects it to be in excellent running condition. There are few things that will cause greater customer dissatisfaction than poor preparation of a new motorcycle. An error or oversight made by the mechanic assembling and servicing a new unit can easily result in fault operation, damage to the machine, or even injury to the rider.

#### CAUTION:

- Take every precaution when removing the shipping crate not to damage the motorcycle.
- The torque values and sizes of bolts and nuts are also indicated below the work sequence number when or deemed necessary. The other bolts, screws and nuts must be tightened to the standard torques.
- Some parts may differ in shape from those illustrated according to market differences.
- After the motorcycle has been set up, perform the pre-delivery inspections as described in the PRE-DELIVERY SERVICE CHECKLIST at the back of manual.
- Refer to owner's manual for specifications and detailed procedures. Always test ride
  the unit to make sure that it is functioning properly.

- Each loose part is indexed to the work sequence number ([1][2]...). Install or remove the loose parts in the order indicated.
- · Tally all loose parts with the Parts List in the manual.
